INTAKE PROCESS FOR MUSEUM DONATIONS AND CONSIGNMENTS

GUIDELINES

- **Artwork MUST BE authentic Native American**
- No more than 20 pieces per person
- Art cannot weigh more than 30 pounds
- No broken items or items with missing pieces

DONATION AND CONSIGNMENT

MUSEUM DONATION

- Donate your artwork to the Collectors' Sale museum fundraiser and receive a 100% tax deduction.

ARTWORK CONSIGNMENT

- Consign your artwork and receive 60% of the price of each piece sold.
- The museum will retain 40% of the sale to support museum exhibitions and educational programs — and offset event production costs.

PLEASE COMPLETE REQUIRED FORMS in advance of your appointment or walk-in.

- Be sure to set your asking price for each piece
Minimum price of \$50 and maximum of \$8,000; price will not be adjusted
