Objects which are rare, unique, suitable for exhibit, or which require superior security or special storage conditions may be selected by museum curators from the materials submitted to the Archaeological Research Collections to be housed in the Museum's Individually Cataloged Collections. Because these objects, as well as human remains, require special handling and storage, and more detailed cataloguing, they will be charged at the 1 cubic foot rate, regardless of size/volume. In general, transferring objects to the Individually Cataloged Collections is a very rare occurrence, and human remains should only be submitted to the Museum for curation when tribal consultation does not result in repatriation or reburial.

**Note:** As always, Archaeological Research Collections (ARC) staff will do the final boxing of collections at the Museum, and the invoice prepared will be based on the number and size of ARC standard boxes filled. **The fees quoted above assume that the submitted collections are prepared in accordance with the ARC Procedures Manual for Submission of Collections.** Additional fees will be charged if Museum staff must process the collection to current standards.
